GMP Planning Timeline

Winter-Spring 2009 Refine the Draft Alternatives.

Summer-Fall 2009 Produce the Draft GMP/ELS and complete policy reviews. Winter 2009 Publish the Draft GMP/ELS and distribute for public review.

2010-2011 Final GMP/EIS and Record of Decision. Begin to implement...

Objectives are to **improve trail condition and quality**, landscape **ecological**




