

Pillar Point Bluff

- POST acquired in 2004 for \$2.7 million
 - \$1 million grant from Coastal Conservancy
 - \$1 million gift from Al and Kathy Lauer
- Protected property from development
- Preserved coastal access
- Important addition to Fitzgerald Marine Reserve





Coastal Conservancy provided \$500K in grants for Coastal Trail planning, permitting and construction

Formalize trail system into section of California Coastal Trail


Reduce erosion


Restore and protect habitat

Improve emergency access


Increase public safety





Significant erosion at bluff edges exacerbated by informal trails






New trails help to reduce erosion and impacts on sensitive habitat
