Dear Bill:

The Half Moon Bay Fishermans Marketing Association reaffirms its support for the dissolution of the San Mateo County Harbor District.

We support the following factors related to this dissolution:

1. The 1990 Grand Jury's report
2. The County Manager's report and Parks & Recreation recommendation
3. The Supervisors' resolution committing continued County property tax funds to the San Mateo County Harbor District debts and operating and maintenance costs, with any savings from dissolution to be applied toward early debt retirement.

We encourage the negotiation of early maturation of the joint powers agreement with South San Francisco. We also request that commercial fishing have a strong representation on the proposed Pillar Point User Advisory Board. Commercial fishing has the longest history as revenue generators and promoters of the development of Pillar Point Harbor. We continue to be the major revenue generators as well as the main tourist attraction of a working commercial/recreational harbor.

For nearly two decades we have tried in good faith to provide meaningful user group impact to the San Mateo County Harbor District. The policies and actions of the Harbor Commissioners reflect a disregard for the importance of commercial fishing at Pillar Point Harbor.

Therefore, we strongly urge LAFCO to place dissolution of the San Mateo County Harbor District before the voters of San Mateo County.
