The Midcoast Community Council (MCC) is an elected Municipal Advisory Council to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors, serving the citizens of the unincorporated Midcoast in Miramar, El Granada, Princeton, Moss Beach, and Montara.

The MCC fully supports the County's application to fund the planning and permitting of the Midcoast Highway 1 Parallel Trail, which would provide a non-motorized inter-community transportation route from Half Moon Bay to Montara. The MCC supports prioritizing the southern Midcoast segment (east-side highway right-of-way from northern Half Moon Bay city limit to Coronado in El Granada) for the greatest near-term value and connectivity due to the near completion of Half Moon Bay's Naomi Patridge Trail.
