 - a. <u>La Costanera Restaurant</u> (PLN2006-00494) Use Permit Amendment, Revised Initial Study & Negative Declaration, Design Review Permit, Planned Agricultural District Permit, and Grading Permit to:
 - Expand restaurant hours to daytime on Fridays and weekends.
 - Legalize exterior building improvements (lighting, patios).
 - Formalize and improve adjacent State Parks beach parking lot.

Coastal Development Permit (CDP) for this project is directly under the jurisdiction of the California Coastal Commission (CCC) and will be reviewed separately by them. County Use Permit Amendment, if approved by the Planning Commission, will not go into effect until and unless the CCC approves an amended CDP that was originally issued by them in 1977, which limited restaurant hours to after 5pm to provide for adequate parking via shared beach parking.

Desired Outcome: Approve comments to the Planning Commission, building on earlier MCC comments to County Planner (3/12/14 and 12/12/12).
