## Subject: Change of Regular Board Meeting Dates to Avoid Conflicts

For many years there was no conflict in meeting dates between the Coastside Fire Protection District (CFPD) and other local agencies. A few years ago, the CFPD Board changed its Regular Meeting date to the second Wednesday of the month. This conflicts with the Midcoast Community Council (MCC) Regular Meeting dates which have always been held on the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month. This is a disservice to our mutual constituents who may sometimes want or need to attend both meetings.

The Midcoast Community Council respectfully requests that the Coastside Fire Protection District change its meeting date to one which doesn't conflict with other local agencies, notably Midcoast Community Council (MCC), Half Moon Bay City Council (HMBCC), San Mateo County Harbor District (SMC HD), Cabrillo Unified School District (CUSD), Coastside County Water District (CCWD), Montara Water and Sanitary District (MWSD), Granada Sanitary District (GSD), and Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside (SAM).

Excluding Fridays and weekends, there are 16 potential dates for regular monthly meetings. Avoiding the dates that MCC, HMBCC, SMC HD, CUSD, CCWD, MWSD, GSD, and SAM meet leaves the following non-conflicting dates of each month:

First, second, and third Mondays Fourth Tuesdays Second and fourth Thursdays

We ask, in the public interest, for the Coastside Fire Protection District to change its regular meeting date to one of the above 6 possibilities.
