2. Community Forum -- The public is invited to speak on any topic not on the agenda. The Council, however, can take no action if the item is not on the Regular Agenda. ***Due to Brown Act requirements, Council members may respond to questions and ask for clarification of comments, but may not otherwise discuss items not on the agenda. Specific topics which come up may be placed on a future agenda for Council discussion / action.*** Estimated Start: 7:40 p.m. If necessary, Community Forum may be interrupted for the first item of Regular Business and continued after the first Regular Business item.

3. Consent Agenda – The Council generally approves Consent Agenda items as a group, without discussion, but upon request any item may be moved to the Regular Agenda for discussion. If any Council member or any member of the public requests discussion of an item on the Consent Agenda, it will be removed from Consent and held for discussion. Depending on time considerations, such discussion may take place immediately following approval of the remaining Consent Agenda items, or may be moved to follow the Regular Agenda.
