

Devil's Slide Repair Project Midcoast Community Council Meeting

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will provide an update on the Devil's Slide Repair Project on Wednesday June 14, 2006. A presentation of the latest information will be followed by a question and answer period. The meeting will be at the Seton Medical Center, Moss Beach and is open to all members of the public.

Highway 1 was closed on April 2, 2006 following a slipout at Devil's Slide. Caltrans immediately formed a project team to restore the road to a safe condition as soon as possible. Senior Caltrans officials, in conjunction with local councils and other government agencies, are working closely to address problems communities are facing because the road is closed.

This meeting is part of a series designed to keep the public informed about repair progress. It is also an opportunity to ask questions and provide public comment about the project.
