The Planning and Zoning Committee of the MidCoast Community Council reviewed the abovereferenced application at it's regular meeting of October 6, 2004. Our comments are as follows.

The Committee recommends approval of the project as presented with the request for the following conditions:

- The work of the project should be phased to avoid disruption to large areas of Montara at one time.
- Street closures or partial blockings should be limited to non-commute hours to avoid impact to school and commute traffic, and noticed along route at least one week before work commences.
- Excavation, material staging, and construction in residential areas should not begin until after 8:30 am.
- Trees along the project areas should be marked and fenced for protection, and any damage to root systems or tree trunks should be remedied with proper treatment of the tree by an arborist and replacement, if necessary.
- 5. All excavated areas will be covered, fenced off and properly noticed with warning signs at night.
- Proper stormwater and runoff BMPs will be implemented.
