Dear Chris;

At the 4/3/02 meeting of the MCC P&Z Committee, we reviewed the above application with Mr. Childers in attendance. We had the following comments:

- 1. We were glad to see that the applicant would not be installing a sea wall or rip-rap at this time, and we would like to see this component removed from the application. Our understanding is the moved structures would be supported by house jacks, be fenced off from unauthorized access, would not be allowed for any occupancy and would have no utility connections.
- 2. As it may be some time before final permits for the permanent resetting of the structures are completed and approved, and as there could be further collapse of the cliff during this time, we would like a condition that the old foundation and sidewalks for the "hotel" building be removed, filled in, stabilized with proper drainage and revegetated as soon as possible.
