Dear Neil,

During the MidCoast Community Council's Joint Public Works and Planning and Zoning Committee meeting on January 29, 2003, we had several members of the community and property owners on Date Street express their concerns regarding the drumage impacts of several new homes proposed near Date and Franklin Streets. These concerns included the rapidly increase flooding & drumage problems at Date/Cedar Harte Street.

There have been contraductory reports by residents, builders and Design Review Committee members regarding proposed plans for drainage improvements in northeastern Montant. At least five homes have been proposed in this area over the past twelve to eighteen months. This is equivalent to the development of a minor sub-division, we are concerned that individual developments are being reviewed on a site by site, basis only while not taking into account the cumulative impact of all these approved and proposed projects. There are potential long term effects on the creek adjacent to and fed by the wetlands near this developing area.

We request clarification of any imminent plans for drainage improvements in the Mick 'oast. We are also eager to receive information regarding any conditions being placed for development in the Date Street Area to improve current problems and minimize any additional run-off, rate, speed or flow of surface and ground water.

Please contact me (us) with any questions or suggestions you have to expedite a plan for the development of this area which is most beneficial for the health and safety to residents and the protection of the surrounding watershed
