To Whom It May Concern:

Thank you, Dwight, for your email update posted to the Midcoast list. The Midcoast Community Council appreciates your attempt to address our concerns. I apologize that a letter in response to Roy Salume's email has not been written yet.

The MCC is concerned that separating the Midcoast from Half Moon Bay in the process of selecting a middle school site would not create a good working relationship, but would lead to more division and separation. As the advisory council to the Board of Supervisors regarding development and land use on the Midcoast, where half of CUSD enrollment resides, we're of the view that it's important for all of us to have these discussions around a single table. The Half Moon Bay City Council apparently agrees, having publicly endorsed MCC participation in the meetings they are having with the school board.

The Midcoast Community Council by unanimous vote agreed that to best serve the residents we must be included in the entire process jointly with CUSD and the City of Half Moon Bay. We also suggest that Jonathan Lundell be present to represent the South Coast.
