Dear Carol,

On June 13, 2000 your Board discussed a non-priority service connection transfer policy for properties accorded Measure A allocations in Half Moon Bay and developable lots in the unincorporated area. At that time Deputy County Counsel Michael Murphy appeared on behalf of the County of San Mateo to express my concerns relative to fairness for any transfer policy that should be put in place.

I understand that you deferred action and will continue a discussion of this item at your July 11th meeting. I would hope that as you further discuss this issue, that you keep in mind our willingness to be involved. Specifically, I would hope that you would accept this letter as a request that the County be included in any process you may undertake for the development of transfer program options. I would be happy to meet with you and/or District staff to ascertain what information or assistance you might need.

I believe that close coordination with the City of Half Moon Bay, the County of San Mateo, and Coastside County Water District will be important to creating an equitable transfer program that will serve the best interests of all of the agencies and the public.
