At our meeting of 3/21/01 the Planning & Zoning Committee of the MidCoast Community Council considered the above referenced application on our Consent Agenda.. We had the following comments:

As presented, the addition would be to the front of the existing second story, matching existing roof lines and materials. Style of "tall single-story" would be maintained (roof slope cuts into side wall on second level) – house well articulated and fits in well of area of mixed one and two story homes. No change to lot coverage. Proposed FAR is well under allowable limit. No variances, exemptions or tree removal involved.
