This is an addendum to our earlier letter of 10/1/01 concerning this project.

On Tuesday, October 2, Karen Wilson and I met with the applicant to review a new design they would like to submit. This was a single story design, approx. 1800 sq. ft., and a much better choice for this location.

As it was presented to us, the house would be situated to meet all setbacks, lot coverage and FAR requirements, and the design of the house would minimize its impact on the small cottage next door.

We discussed the addition of a few architectural details that would give the house more of a cottage feel, as well as a color scheme that would integrate well with the neighborhood.

We feel that if this design is submitted as we saw it, it would satisfy the concerns and issues we had with the original proposal, and it would not need to return to the MCC P&Z Committee for review again.

Please let me know when the plans have been submitted and I will stop by and verify them. I would also suggest that the revised project be sent to he neighbors, to allay their concerns about the original project.

Thank you for your help, and, as usual, please keep us informed of any further developments, redesigns, hearings, approvals or appeals concerning this application.
