The Council may vote to take appropriate action on any of the following items:

- 1. Presentation and possible recommendation regarding City of Half Moon Bay request to divert County road funds for intersection improvements within the City. Half Moon Bay is planning upgrades to Highway 92 between Main Street and Route 1, including signal coordination, widening, landscaping, and other changes. They would like the Council to recommend that the County allow them to use funds collected within the unincorporated areas of the Midcoast, and intended for road improvements within the Midcoast, to be applied instead to their project. - Presentation on environmental issues related to aquaculture of abalone. Barbara Mauz has arranged with Duncan Mac Lean for a brief presentation. Estimated Start: 9:00 p.m. Sponsor: Paul Perkovic.
- 3. Recommendation to California Coastal Commission regarding substandard lots in the Midcoast. Several members of our community spoke at the recent Commission hearing in Long Beach, and were encouraged by the Commission to submit recommendations on how the Commission might approach the statewide problem of historic substandard lots in the Coastal Zone. The Council may be asked to approve a letter. Estimated Start: 10:00 p.m. Sponsor: Ric Lohman.
