NEW BUSINESS

1. ABAG PROPOSAL Estimated time: 7:30 pm

The Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) has issued a Request For Proposal in which they offer to fund "subregional planning groups." The City of Half Moon Bay is proposing to submit a proposal, in which Pacifica, Half Moon Bay, the MCCC, and the County would participate in such a planning group.
