Re: Subcommittee Report on Boards and Commissions

The MidCoast Community Council provides a public forum twice monthly for open and broad based discussions of issues of interest to the Board of Supervisors and to the residents of the MidCoast. The MidCoast Community Council has elections this fall for four of the seven seats, in what could be a referendum on the future of the MidCoast Community Council. The MidCoast Community Council serves the Board of Supervisors in an advisory capacity as established by the 1990 resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

The MidCoast Community Council welcomes the desire of the Board of Supervisors to institute a broad based and specific review of the various Boards and Commissions that provide input to the Board.

The MidCoast Community Council believes that the two elected bodies, the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council (PMAC) and the MidCoast Community Council (MC3) should remain as is: elected by the people - as overwhelming endorsed by a people in a separate/ specific referendum in 1991. After much discussion and input from the Community, the MidCoast Community Council voted unanimously to support the basic goals / objectives of the Board's subcommittee report on Boards and Commissions with this one exception.

The Council looks forward to working closely with the Board of Supervisors and their staff during this review process and during its implementation.
