Citizens Utilities water/fire flow

After some discussion, Council voted 5-0 in favor of motion to recommend to Board of Supervisors that a qualified expert witness be provided on behalf of Montara/Moss Beach Fire District to testify at PUC hearing on May 10th and 11th 1994, said witness to focus on the water supply issue affecting fire safety.

In connection with the above, it will be suggested that the County support the efforts of Fire Chief Dave Eufusia (who was present) on this matter. Council member Hayes-Kane will prepare the letter to Supervisors, which will be submitted through Council Chair.

A new water subcommittee was formed consisting of Council Members Campbell, Hayes-Kane, and Fitting.

Montara State Beach Parking Lot Expansion

Discussion led by Council members Fitting and Marsh regarding extension of permit by Coastal Commission to State Parks to expand parking lot. Clarification needed as to project size for Council to take action.

Chris Stone from Montara Sanitary District pointed out that sewage issue is germane to parking lot expansion, and that the District should be included in the discussion, even though the proposed lot is just outside Urban-rural Boundary.
