RE: Quarry Park Update and Forum January 11th 1995

Honorable Board Members:

In November, Measures E and F were defeated by a 3.5% margin, clearly indicating a majority of 62.9% of the Midcoast residents would like to see a Parks District established. During the past four weeks, our subcommittee has discussed the options available in acquiring the Quarry site as well as establish a Parks District.

On December 9th, the subcommittee met with the Matt Greenberg, Mike Murphy and Paul Koenig. We discussed the results of the ballot measure and how we can now proceed most expediently to acquire the site. The process is rather complicated and lengthy to explain. We are now at a point where we need to have a Community Forum to listen to the public as well as inform them of our ideas and options.

We are looking at the possibility of establishing a CSA (County Service Area) or a CSD (Community Services District). Each of these options has limitations and implied powers that we need to examine. One of our highest goals is to maintain as much local control as possible and seek funding from both the private and public sectors.

Thank you for your time regarding this matter and we look forward to examining our options to create a Parks District in the Midcoast on January 11th 1995. Please let me know of our time constraints at this meeting.
