We propose a format for each district or council election in which each candidate may present an Opening Statement of three minutes or less (total of 48 minutes if all 16 candidates appear, plus 6 minutes for Measure H pro and con), followed by questions from the Council or the public regarding the race. For introductory statements and questions, we would combine all candidates for a given district, regardless of whether a candidate is standing for a two-year or four-year term.

We expect the amount of time appropriate for questions would vary from race to race, and suggest initially allocating 15 minutes for each race, which could be extended at the discretion of the Chair. We have scheduled an extended question period for the Mid-Coast Community Council candidates, as we feel these will draw the most interest.
