
Dear Mr. Kelly and Captain Peterson:

The Midcoast Community Council is an elected agency which advises the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors. Two members of that Council have written the enclosed letter which I ask that you read. An additional letter of support for their concept is also enclosed.

Ms. Campbell and Ms. Meyer make several suggestions regarding ways in which traffic safety could be improved between Devil's Slide and Moss Beach. In reviewing the letter, it occurred to me that traffic safety in this area is also related to patrolling by the CHP, hence my letter to you both.

I would appreciate it if CalTrans and CHP would work together to investigate the suggestions which are made in this letter and to develop other options for traffic safety which might be appropriate. I believe that traffic volume is growing in this area and that the State should be trying to manage the problem through additional methods. I know that your two offices, by working together, can probably develop strategies which are workable and which will help alleviate the problems. Please feel free to contact me or Brian Perkins in my District Office when your staffs have had an opportunity to consider the enclosed suggestions and other options. I look forward to hearing from you within a few weeks, after the professional staffs have had an opportunity to consult with each other.
