MINUTES **Regular Meeting** **April 28, 1993**

1. **Call to Order** at 7:12 pm

Present: Bledsoe, Brown, Campbell, Marsh, Meyer
Absent: Ayers, Dove

2. **Approval of Minutes**

March 10, 1993 meeting (Marsh/Meyer) approved 4-0
April 14, 1993 meeting (Meyer/Marsh) approved with amendments 4-0

3. **Public Comment**

Joe Reid (Half Moon Bay Pilots Assn.) discussed planning for the 2nd annual HMB Airshow, November 6&7

Mary Hobbs (Sierra Club) requested that discussion of SR92 widening be agendized; also complained re: airplane noise

Sally Campbell (Harbor District) stated US Dept. of Commerce was limiting salmon season from 3 months to 30 days

Don Horsley (candidate for SM Co. Sheriff) introduced himself

Margaret Abe (aide to Anna Eschoo) introduced herself

Nadia Bledsoe announced the Siege on Sacramento demonstration May 19 re: state financial hits on local government

4. **Consent Calendar** - No items.

5. **Finance Committee Report**

Jim Marsh presented a draft budget/funding request and cover letter to the County Manager. The proposal includes in-kind expenses for the meeting room and office.

Motion (Brown/Marsh): Forward budget request and letter with the following amendments:

- Revise budget into Tier I and Tier II requests. Tier I would include all items except Telephone (reduced to \$200) and Clerical, and increase Newsletter printing to \$1040, and modify category titles per Joan Briody's suggestions.
- Revise letter to acknowledge tough budget conditions of County as reason for two tier request, and focus on newsletter production as major 1993 goal to better solicit community feedback for benefit of the Board and to expedite fundraising.

Motion approved 4-0.

Marsh, Ayers and Dove were suggested to lobby the County Manager and Board Members.

6. **1993 Council Work Program**

Continued to May 12 meeting.

7. **Devil's Slide**

Nancy Maule presented a history of the Devil's Slide bypass issue. The Council agreed that additional education was appropriate. Marsh, Dove and Ms. Maule will propose a process for community meetings with involvement by Caltrans, marine biologists and engineers.

8. **Seaside Inn Application**

The County has placed poles on the project site indicating the proposed building height. Council and public comments were made in opposition to the building height and proximity to property lines and bluff.

Motion (Marsh/Meyer): That Bob Brown be directed to modify the Council's position letter to the County to express concerns about the size and height of the proposed building and the need for better view corridors to the ocean.
