

**GUIDELINES FOR COUNCIL INVOLVEMENT/TAKING ON NEW ISSUES**  
(all criteria must be met)

1. No other agencies exist to address the problem, and/or contacts with responsible agencies have been ineffective.
2. Resolution of the issue would be of benefit to significant segments of the community or is precedent-setting.
3. A Council member and/or community volunteer(s) are willing to take charge of investigating or responding to the issue.
4. The issue can be dealt with without reprioritizing the Council's work program or the Council agrees to a reprioritization.
