Hi Sam,

I had difficulty translating the colors shown in the legend to the colors shown by the maps. For example, we are still evaluating alternative alignments for the parallel trail segments adjacent to the airport (i.e., east or west of Hwy 1), and at the south end of Montara (i.e., along Farallone or Main). The maps do not appear to reflect this fact.

Why is there no coastal edge strand of the coastal trail between Columbia and Capistrano in Princeton (e.g., slide 5)? While current physical constraints may be significant, we should preserve the possibility that the ultimate solution to the shoreline erosion problem (TBD by the Princeton Planning Effort) could provide continuous lateral shoreline access.

What is the alignment of the CT between 2nd and 10th streets in Montara (Slide 8)? I assume along Main St.

What is the "property issue" associated with use of the Strand (Slide 18)?
