I apologize for the delay in getting back to you.

State Parks staff support the general concepts for trails and parking as presented in the Conceptual Plan for CA Coastal Trail in Midcoast between Princeton and Pacifica. Actual alignments and project design will require a more complete analysis of site conditions, potential environmental impacts, and project alternatives. For example, the conceptual design for parking at Montara State Beach specifies the use of permeable pavement; in our experience, there are other ways to appropriately disperse runoff that should be considered in lieu of permeable surfaces. We will have additional comments as more specific designs are developed.
