This office represents the San Mateo County Planning and Building Department and, from time to time, we are asked to assist in coordinating the County's response to requests from those seeking licenses from the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for certificates of public convenience or necessity. Specifically, in cases where a certain threshold of such licenses has already been exceeded, the operator must receive from the local governmental agency with land use regulatory jurisdiction over the area in question a certificate that the public convenience or necessity would be served by issuance of such a license.

As reflected on the attached form, J7 Companies LLC seeks such a certificate from the County in connection with the proposed sale of alcoholic beverages at 2305 Carlos Street, #A, in the unincorporated Moss Beach area. In addition to the attached form, the applicant provided the following description of the proposed business: "The Wine Room, Moss Beach will be the only wine tasting sit down wine bar on the coast side covering Half Moon Bay to Montara. There will be places at the bar to sit along with comfortable chairs to lounge in. We will have a sommelier there who will educate our customers on wine to heighten their awareness of local wines. I believe that these two facts, will bring it more customers and will increase other retail stores business in the neighborhood."

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As part of the process for consideration of such a request, the County seeks the recommendation of the Midcoast Community Council.
