The hosting agencies will be holding a CERT training on four consecutive Thursday evenings starting April 3rd through April 24th from 6:00PM to 9:30PM and a final exercise Saturday April 26th from 8:30-4:30 PM. No registration fee is required. Student manuals will be available electronically. A personal response pack and a CERT field operations guide will be provided. A drill will be held on the last day to practice the skills you have learned. The class will provide 20 + hours of FEMA designed training for citizens to become trained to assist First Responders during disasters.

This is a very rewarding and "fun" way to learn techniques for search and rescue, triage, Incident Command structure, emergency communications and more with your neighbors and friends.
