TITLE: APPOINTMENT OF GENERAL PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (GPAC) MEMBERS

RECOMMENDATION

Appoint General Plan Advisory Committee (GPAC) members as recommended by the City Council subcommittee.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost to facilitate the GPAC is included as an overall part of the scope of work for the General Plan Update agreement awarded to Dyett and Bhatia by the City Council on June 18, 2013.

BACKGROUND

Dyett & Bhatia was hired by the City Council on June 18, 2013 to prepare an updated General Plan, Local Coastal Land Use Plan, and Zoning Code. As part of this update process the City is expected to establish a GPAC. The GPAC will be an integral part of the General Plan update process, as 13 City Council-appointed committee members will keep residents and organizations/stakeholder groups informed of its progress, and will also provide constructive feedback on the process and work in progress, and make recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council at key project milestones.

At its September 3, 2013 City Council meeting the Council established the GPAC and adopted a GPAC Mission Statement and Principles of Participation. At the October 15, 2013 City Council meeting, the Mayor established a GPAC applicant review subcommittee comprising of Councilmembers Alifano and Patridge. This subcommittee was charged with reviewing applications and listening to presentations made by the applicants and bringing a recommendation of proposed GPAC appointments to the full Council.

Attached to this Staff report is a list of the 25 applicants to the GPAC. The GPAC will consist of 13 members and 3 alternates to provide a diversity of viewpoints that are broadly representative of and reflect the diversity of the community to the greatest extent possible. The GPAC will include members representing the following groups:
