Capistrano Road Parking Bays Timeline

6/23/81: County No-Parking Ordinance on Capistrano from Prospect to Highway 1 south, except for parking bays.

9/23/15: DPW confirms that Oceano Hotel painted red curbs in parking bays on their own, which are not enforceable.

10/14/15: MCC letter requests that parking be restored within parking bays except for fire hydrant access.

11/16/15: DPW informs Oceano that <u>Cal Fire is OK with the existing ordinance</u> and that unauthorized red curb paint must be removed.

9/20/16: <u>Cal Fire requests no-parking</u> zones within the Capistrano Road parking bays to ensure adequate space for emergency response.




Red lines indicate parking bays proposed for no parking on Capistrano Road.





Road Standards for Montara, Moss Beach, Princeton, & Miramar
