Traffic Operational Systems Improvement Project

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to install Wireless Detection Systems sensors, Variable Message Signs, and Maintenance Vehicle Pullouts to assist with equipment maintenance, and to replace existing guardrails with the Midwest Guardrail System. Caltrans is proposing to construct this project to improve day-to-day traffic management capabilities for Caltrans, cities, and first responders on State Route 1, from post mile (PM) 26.4 to PM R47.3 in the City of Half Moon Bay and the City of Pacifica, both in San Mateo County, California.
