Sorry to hear that the property and the house has experienced movement as a result of the recent heavy rains. To ensure proper temporary and long-term stabilization of the site, please implement actions that the County requested ASAP. They are:

- 1. Make the remaining changes to the submitted Erosion Control Plan (EC Plan) requested by the County on 11/28/16:
- a. The EC plan needs to show (Provide revised EC plans to the Building Department by 12/8/16---deadline passed). Please submit revised plans ASAP:
- No off-site work can be shown on the plans unless authorization from the property owner(s) is provided to the County. [This was a comment from my 10/19/16 email].
- Show location of trench to be backfilled
- Restore grade to natural contours
- b. Erosion control measures, as proposed and with suggestions by staff, should be implemented. If necessitated by the civil or geotechnical engineer, this can be done prior to approval of the EC Plan by the County. However, the scope of EC Measures should not exceed EC plans as proposed and modified by the County.
- 2. Adequately address Geo Comments (attached) on the permanent stabilization measures (BLD2016-00745) ASAP.
- 3. Please call Joan Kling (Code Compliance, 650-363-4011) this week. The County is interested in talking to the owner directly to make sure the owner understands the County's requests. A Citation was issued on 12/28/16, with a deadline of today. Pay all citation fines and implement measures described above within 2 weeks (by January 25, 2017) to avoid further enforcement procedures, including recordation of a violation on the property title.
- 4. FYI Our County Geologist plans to inspect potential damage to this and nearby properties within a week to determine if a change in the course of action is necessary to mitigate any emergencies.

I recommended applicant to send letter to Community Development Director & request an emergency CDP. The request needs to include a letter from the geotechnical consultant stating the urgency of the CDP. Include history of how /why the work began in the first place, to trigger the stop work notice and violation. State all options/solutions to repair the work or if there is only one solution, state why there is only one solution. Attach more photos, view from the ocean & capture views of the distance of ocean from area of work.

Per Dave & Melissa, I took in the standard CDP fees. I did notify applicant that due to VIO & Stop Work Notice, penalty fee will apply, CDP fee charged twice. Applicant should also request reduction in fee to Steve Monowitz & state reason for fee reduction.

There is no grading permit - plans state 20 cubic yards of grading. Gave C3C6 for applicant to complete.
