Nominal time is three minutes, which can be adjusted based on the number of speakers. *Due to Brown Act requirements, Councilmembers may respond to questions and ask for clarification of comments, but may not otherwise discuss or take action on items not on the agenda.* If necessary, Public Comment may be interrupted for the first item of Regular Business and continued later in the meeting.

Consent Agenda – The Council generally approves Consent Agenda items as a group, without discussion, but upon request by councilmember or member of the public, any item may be moved to the Regular Agenda for discussion. Depending on time considerations, such discussion may take place immediately following approval of the remaining Consent Agenda items, or may be moved to follow the Regular Agenda.
