

Agenda Item 4a: Highway 1 Parallel Trail segment priority for the 2013 County application for Transportation Authority (TA) Measure A funding.

Background:

The Parallel Trail, aka "Route 1 pedestrian/bike trail from Montara through Half Moon Bay" is listed in the TA Strategic Plan 2009-2013 as eligible for Measure A sales tax transportation funding.

MCC comments on Highway 1 Mobility Study Phase 2, 3/28/12:

Re Parallel Trail: "The east-side parallel trail, as intercommunity alternative transportation, has long been a priority and is identified in the Measure A Strategic Plan for 2009-2013."

Under near-term priority: "MCC work with county to find funding for engineering study on the parallel trail."

Highway 1 Mobility Study Action Plan, adopted 11/9/2012, page 5:

Parallel Trail next steps: identify preferred alignments and development phases. Divide into appropriate segments to allow for phased development.

Supervisor Horsley's Midcoast priorities for 2013 include obtaining "Safe Routes to School" grant funding for Farallone View School students. The trail improvements would be for the Parallel Trail on Carlos St. in Moss Beach and Main St. in Montara, and would provide a safe trail connecting these two streets.

Supervisor Horsley's Midcoast priorities for 2013 also include obtaining TA Measure A funding for a Parallel Trail segment. The MCC is invited to prioritize what that segment will be.
