Mitigation Strategy: Examples

"Sustained action taken to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property"


- Seismic retrofit of buildings and bridges
- Redundancy of water systems and fuel systems
- Tree planting to reduce heat in urban cores
- Education programs to be better informed of risks
- Policies
 – building codes and zoning
- Incentives grants or financial assistance for risk reduction at business and household level

Benefits of Hazard Mitigation Plans

- Establish eligibility for grant funds (\$\$\$ for projects)
- Improve understanding of risks and vulnerabilities
- Reduce negative impact of natural hazards actions save lives, reduce displacement, and speed recovery
- Encourage sustainable actions builds strong, resilient, and self-sufficient communities
- Foster collaboration between local jurisdictions and residents

Timeline





- Schedule projects an 8-month time frame, with 6 months for plan development
- Target for submittal to CalOES would be End of August 2021

 - CalTrans Properties with eucalyptus:
 - Hwy 1 north of Lantos Tunnel
 - Hwy 1 Frenchman's Creek

 - Hwy 92
 - R.O.W. from Pacifica Moss Beach
 - El Granada medians with eucalyptus
 - Quarry Park >> permanent revegetation


