c. (8:45) Historical Overview of Coastal Armoring to Protect Development in the Midcoast – (Ketcham). Slide presentation on existing coastal armoring and current CCC policies prohibiting future armoring of new development.

Desired outcome: Informational only.

d. (9:00) Consideration of MCC comments on the proposed development of 6 houses on Vallemar Bluff (PLN2015-00380) – (Ketcham).

*Desired outcome*: Approve initial Council comments on the development proposal, considering past (1997-2001) and current Council and community input.

e. (9:15) MCC support for County grant application (due Dec 18) for \$517,000 for design through construction of pedestrian crossing at lighthouse/16th St. – (Calderón). The County recently learned that the crossing with flashing beacon at this location could not be included in the current Congestion & Safety Improvement Project.

Desired outcome: Authorize MCC Chair to write and submit a letter of support for the grant application.
