

**Surfer's Beach Shoreline Protection Project
Community Meeting Feb 26, 2015**

The County of San Mateo has partnered with Caltrans and the City of Half Moon Bay to design a shoreline protection device project that will protect Highway 1 from further coastal erosion and enhance coastal access and recreation at Surfer's Beach.

As designed, the project consists of a Rock Slope Protection retaining wall to protect Highway 1's embankment from further damage, restoration of the 400-foot long segment of the Coastal Trail to complete the Coastal Trail in the region and a staircase to provide safe pedestrian access to the beach.

Supervisor Don Horsley and the County of San Mateo are hosting a community meeting regarding the Surfer's Beach Shoreline Protection Project on Thursday, Feb. 26 at 7 p.m. at the Granada Community Services District office at 504 Avenue Alhambra in El Granada. This will be the final community meeting before a Coastal Development Permit Application is submitted to the California Coastal Commission for review.
