San Diego, CA, Feb. 6, 2024 - The San Diego Chapter of Lambda Alpha International (LAI), at its 46th annual Crystal Globe award and installation dinner on Feb. 3, recognized Ernest Rady for his achievements in real estate and his philanthropic contributions to the San Diego region.
