## **JOB SUMMARY**

Storyhill Church values caring for the lives of unreached and vulnerable neighbors in our community, our region, and our world as we join with God in advancing the hope and mercy of Jesus. The Missions Director's role is to be the visionary champion of this aspect of Serving together by engaging in the Holy Spirit's redemptive mission and creating ongoing opportunities for Storyhill's congregation to love God, love people, and keep Christ at the center.

## **DUTIES & ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- **Cast vision and raise awareness** of the biblical mandate to care for the vulnerable and lost outside our walls, aligning the approach with Storyhill's mission and vision. This includes communicating, teaching, and leading effectively and passionately across Storyhill's various ministry areas and a diverse range of people by encouraging a church-wide, unified, and integrated approach to caring for our neighbors.
- **Build, develop, and encourage effective teams** by identifying, equipping, and empowering authentic and committed leaders. This includes effectively managing healthy circles of leadership development to employ the congregation's spiritual gifts, callings, and passions.
- **Engage and activate the people of Storyhill** through developing and growing ongoing local and global serving opportunities, recognizing and advancing the synergy that Worship, Grow, and Serve are intertwined in often indistinguishable ways. This includes creating well-led serving opportunities and mission trips with our Mission Partners, effectively moving people from exploring to regularly investing their lives outside the church's walls. This will involve discerning the breadth and depth of current and future initiatives with an eye toward long-term relationship building.
- **Build, develop, and nurture Mission Partner relationships** while assessing and evaluating the effectiveness and growth potentials for mobilizing the church and encouraging Mission Partners in their work

throughout the world. This also may involve developing in-house initiatives and programs at our future facility.

- **Oversee the Missions Budget and the Missions Partnership Team** in conjunction with Storyhill's elder liaison. This involves building new ways of leading Missions ministry in the future while honoring the oversight and partnership of the existing Ministry Partnership Team. This also includes leading and developing the Missions Partnership Team to compassionately, generously and effectively steward Missions funds to align with Storyhill's mission and vision.

## **COMPETENCIES**

- **Organizationally and administratively sound**—able to equip and delegate so that others are best equipped to use their gifts, time, and resources.
- **Relationally oriented**—Must collaborate and work well with various stakeholders including our Mission Partnership Team, Storyhill Ministry Partners, prospective local and global partners seeking funding, Storyhill staff, and elders.
- **Ability to work in a dynamic environment**—Storyhill is growing in size and scope, requiring a flexible, adaptable, and agile leader to work in a rapidly evolving environment. Other duties may be assigned throughout the undulating seasons of the ministry calendar.
- **The ability to develop and equip leaders**—Storyhill's growth requires that leaders develop and empower other leaders so that the Body of Christ is strengthened and individuals are equipped for works of service in His church (Eph. 4:12).
- **Financial Steward**—As the staff leader is accountable for overseeing the Missions budgeting process, the Missions Director must demonstrate wise financial stewardship in their ongoing collaboration with the Missions Partnership Team (MPT). Financial and funding decisions for Missions are made in collaboration with the MPT.
