The first deliberate gap (referred to above) is to be followed by the buses allocated to this space.

The 50 metre gap ahead of these buses **is to be maintained** by the driver of the lead bus.

## SECOND DELIBERATE GAP

An additional, deliberate gap of **50 metres** is to be established, and maintained, between the last of the larger buses, and the first section of Group 3.

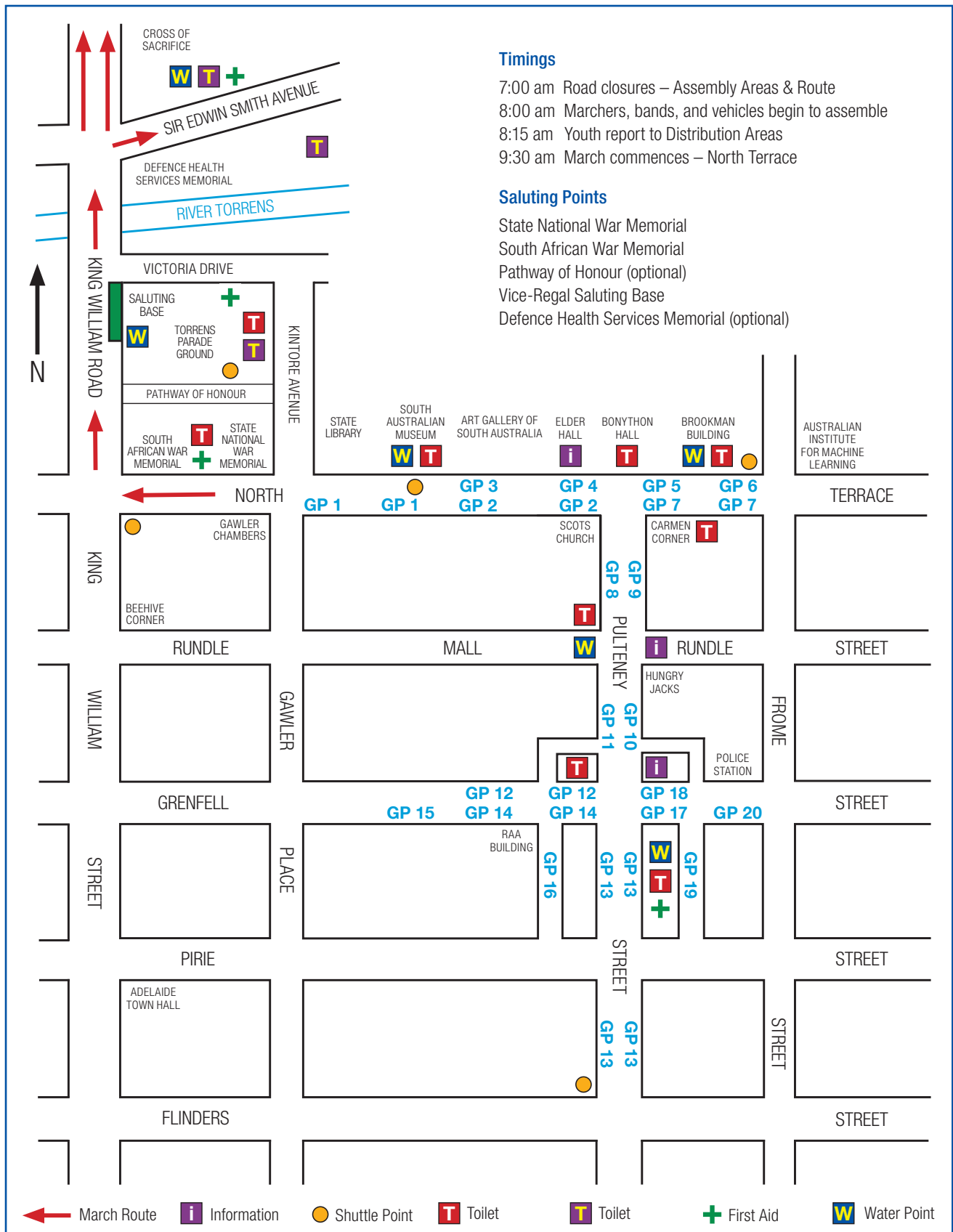

# ADELAIDE ANZAC DAY MARCH - 2023

Commences at 9:30 am from the corner of North Terrace & Gawler Place



## Assembly, Frontages, Shuttle Services, and Commencement of the March

**Reviewing Officer:** Her Excellency The Governor of South Australia will review the March from the Official Dais.

**Assembly:** public vehicle traffic access to the Assembly Areas, and along the March route, is to cease at 7:00 am.

**Shuttle Services to Assembly Areas:** will operate from Torrens Training Depot, the South Australian Museum, Frome Road, King William Road, and Flinders Street between 8:00 am and 9:30 am. Please see orange symbols on map for locations of Departure Points.

**Frontages:** all sections (less bands) are to march 6-abreast – except where ADF ceremonial instructions indicate otherwise, in Group 13.

**March Commencement:** from North Terrace, just east of Gawler Place at 9:30 am.
