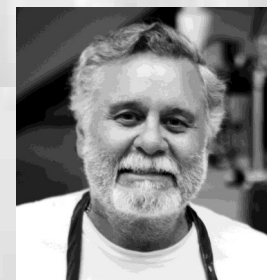
SHARE/WHEEL Tent City 3 206-399-0412
