











Overview

Starting from 2018, the Cimolai Group. a world leader in the realization of large complex works, has decided to undertake a partnership with 4Days for the adoption of Truspace as a platform for the integration and management of all internal and external processes of collaboration with BIM methodology. from design to implementation. The project involved a complex change management process, based on the progressive analysis and reand enaineerina of processes their digitalization within Truspace.

To date, all of Cimolai Group's orders are managed through Truspace, with over 500 active users among internal collaborators, suppliers and customers who collaborate via web on the platform, with hundreds of thousands of documents and models managed. But also, the integration of the phases of Design, SteelDesign, Production, Quality Control, Planning, Construction Site, with important efficiency and quality improvements.









Cimolai Group

Protagonist for over 70 years in the design and realization of complex steel structures, Cimolai S.p.A., owned by **Luigi Cimolai**, currently has a turnover of **about 500 million euros** and employs over **3000 workers** of which 1500 are directly employed **in iconic projects around the world** (Europe, United States, Canada, USA, Canada, Latin America, Middle East and Africa).

These include the largest telescope on the planet, the ELT (Extremely Large Telescope), with a primary mirror with a diameter of 39 meters, which will be located in the Atacama Desert in Chile.

Other projects with great international recognition are: the Al Wasl dome for the EXPO 2020 in Dubai, the Al Bayt stadium in Qatar for the next World Cup, the floodgates for the new Panama Canal, the "Oculus" subway station by Calatrava at Ground Zero in New York, the complex honeycomb structure "Vessel" and the cultural center "The Shed", both in Manhattan. In Italy, among the other works, Cimolai has built the new Terminal of Fiumicino Airport in Rome and the AV railway station in Reggio Emilia.

Finally, the company has cultivated a solid relationship with the shipbuilding market, building the carpentry of ships such as such as **Seabourn Odyssey**, **Sojourn** and **Quest** completed between 2008 and 2010.


In the last two years the **barge Arcalupa** with a loading capacity of 14000 tons, the **RO-RO ferry Iginia** and the extra-luxury cruise ship **Seabourn Venture**, twin of the Pursuit, which was recently completed at the Cimolai plant in San Giorgio di Nogaro and launched last April.











The decision to start the Truspace project with 4Days was made in 2018, within an R&D project that aimed to deeply innovate the process of managing complex projects (www.cimolai.com/it/ricerca-e-sviluppo/).

Project milestone: The adoption of a single solution that integrates all of Cimolai's asset management sub-processes: design, production, and installation.

- The full consistency of the solution with the methodological guidelines of international Building Information Modeling
- A purely WEB and Cloud technology, flexible in the System Integration processes and able to manage the collaboration in a single platform of internal departments, suppliers and customers.
- Compliance with Cimolai specifications in terms of data security
- Measuring efficiency and quality KPIs to support the process of profound change



The **selection** of the partner(s) for this innovation challenge was led by the Group's Technical Director, **Ennio Picco**, and his team. The process was conducted at an **international level** and lasted more than a year as there were no solutions or projects on the market that could fully satisfy the requirements set by Cimolai.

The choice fell on **4Days** as a **partner** and on **Truspace** as a **technological solution**. The main reasons that led to the development of the collaboration were the potential of Truspace solution and the ability of 4Days to accompany projects of deep process reengineering and change management along paths of innovation.





Project 2/2

The project involved the creation of a **mixed team** coordinated by **Denis Durante** (BIM Coordinator and CDE Manager Cimolai) and **Emilio Ziraldo** (Co-Founder and Senior Consultant of 4Days).

The design framework was built on a **two-year roadmap**, featuring **21 goal points** and an approach inspired by Agile methodologies given the complexity.

The commitment of the project team has been weekly, with alternating phases of analysis and re-engineering of processes, experimentation of Truspace for their digitization. prototyping of ad-hoc solutions. testina and of release performance-optimized solutions. extension of approved solutions to staff involved in technical processes.

The project has been constantly tested and formally evaluated by internal and external stakeholders (design partners, end customers such as the European Aerospace Agency) and assessed by a steering committee with Cimolai's main departments.

Over time, the functional coverage, throughout the life cycle of assets managed by Cimolai, has been completed:

collaborative design and the Common Data Environment model, Steel Detailing and Production activities, Quality Control, Logistics and Site management, Time and Progress Planning, integration with the Cimolai management software ecosystem, definition of Integrated Data Analysis models.




At the end of the two years 90% of the project objectives were achieved and Truspace management was extended to all Cimolai orders (over 500 users, hundreds of thousands of documents, models and data managed).

In 2020, planning and collaboration was renewed with the aim of anticipating business and technology evolutions, with a focus on roll-out to all subsidiaries, site and maintenance processes.







Outcome



Project objectives achieved in the first two years: 90%.



Reliability of forecasts and actual costs over the four-year period: 100%.



Efficiencies and savings achieved through customer measurements:

- Design process, estimated 15 people/year, approx. 15%, approx. ...
- Quality process, estimated 7 people per year, approx. 20%.
- Site process, estimated 30 people, approx. 18%.
