

Anne Saxelby Legacy Fund 2022 Apprenticeship Application — Summer

Background

The Anne Saxelby Legacy Fund seeks to sponsor young adults for one month apprenticeship opportunities on farms, similar to those that Anne engaged in during her early 20's. Participants will work full-time with a farm/production team for a 30-day immersive experience during the months of July or August. Apprenticeships will be offered later in the year as well.

- Candidates will be paired with a participating farm or food business for a one month working apprenticeship.
- Apprentices will participate in farming and production activities and will follow a tailored program that gives a general and overarching experience of the operation.
- Apprentices will be compensated \$20 per hour for 40-hour work weeks. Lodging and meals and an expense budget will be provided.
- Travel expenses to and from the host farm will be paid.

The application is open to young adults 17-25, with additional consideration given to graduate students or those in life or career transitions that have led them to a desire to work in food and agriculture.

Description

Required

- Enthusiasm for the ASLF mission.
- A strong work ethic.
- Ability to work outdoors in all types of weather.
- Perform physical activities as needed.
- Basic competency with word processing, spreadsheets, and email calendar software a plus.
- Capable of working alone on a task and with direction from peers and supervisors.
- Attend safety training as required.
- Desire to share the experience through photos, stories, art, or social media.

Work Environment

The work environment will depend on the unique host farm and the season, but participants should expect a variety of conditions and experiences available on a working farm. One should be prepared to work outdoors on a variety of farm types and in variable weather conditions. Chores conducted in facilities may include a production facility such as a cheese making room, livestock barn, packing-house, cheese cave, or a pop-up retail stand at the farmers' market.

Agreement

Once submitted, the ASLF Selection Committee will review the application and schedule an interview with promising candidates. Upon acceptance, an interview with the host farm will be scheduled and the candidate will have an opportunity to review the tailored program.

A formal agreement between the farm, the candidate and ASLF will be provided. The agreement will include the following.

- O Summary of the host farm/ business.
- Outline of apprenticeship curriculum/ essential duties/ responsibilities
- Contact information for all Host Farm personnel and ASLF Liaison
- O Orientation / welcome information / important dates and information
- Code of conduct.

Timeline

- 1. Application due by April 1st, 2022.
- 2. Promising candidates will be contacted for an interview with the ASLF Selection Committee.
- 3. We aim to announce acceptance into the program by May 1st, 2022.
- 4. An interview will be conducted with the candidate and the host farm staff.
- 5. The host farm, ASLF and the candidate will finalize a participant agreement.
- 6. Most apprenticeships will take place in **July and August** 2022.
- 7. Participants will be asked to share their experience as an ASLF scholar.
