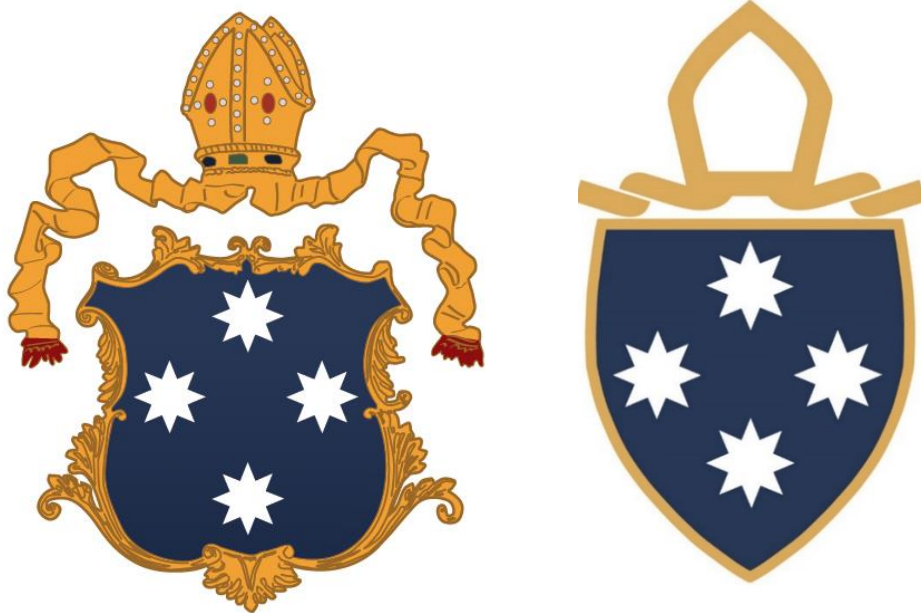


# Officials of The Cathedral Church of St Andrew Sydney

Cathedral Constitution passed 13 August 1867.

Consecration at 10:30am on 30 November 1868 by Bishop Barker.

Temporary Cathedral 1842-1868 (removed in 1870).

Architects: Francis Greenway. James Hume. Edmund Blacket.

The Latin inscription on the foundation stone read thus:

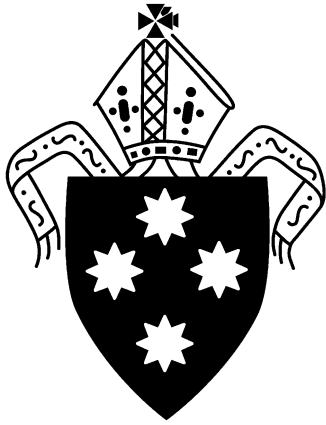

Of this inscription the following is a translation:

The stone which eighteen years ago had been placed at no great distance as the foundation of a Cathedral Church to be consecrated to Almighty God under the name of St Andrew the Apostle by Lachlan Macquarie at that time Governor of the Australian Provinces in consequence of the original situation proving inconvenient through the changes which have taken place in the direction of the streets was removed to this spot by command of Sir Richard Bourke, Knt. of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath Lieutenant General and Governor of the Colony by whom to the honour of God who was in Christ it was afresh and finally laid on the sixteenth day of May in the year of human redemption 1837.
