

Q. Who is AllerGenis?

A. Founded in 2017, AllerGenis started as a collaboration between Genisphere, provider of the 3DNA[®] platform for targeted drug delivery, and Hugh Sampson, MD, of the Elliot and Roslyn Jaffe Food Allergy Institute of the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai. AllerGenis' laboratory is CLIA-certified with state-of-the-art diagnostic testing equipment and specializes in immunological research into epitope mapping technology and food allergies. Currently, AllerGenis is licensed to provide diagnostic testing in 48 states, excluding CA and NY. AllerGenis is a privately owned company, headquartered in Hatfield, PA.

Q. What is VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic?

A. VeriMAPTM Peanut Diagnostic is an innovative diagnostic solution for patients with suspected or diagnosed peanut allergy.

Q. Why is my allergist ordering VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic?

A. Your allergist may order VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic when there is a history consistent with peanut allergy. VeriMAP Peanut Diagnostic is a blood-based test intended to measure reactivity in the plasma of patients with a history consistent with peanut allergy. This test is to be used to confirm a positive or negative diagnosis of IgE-mediated peanut allergy in conjunction with other clinical findings.

Q. How is VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic performed?

A. VeriMAP Peanut Diagnostic is a blood-based test, requiring a small blood sample. Your allergist will either draw the blood sample in the office or arrange for AllerGenis to send a mobile phlebotomist to your home or the allergist's office.

Q. Should I "fast" prior to having my blood drawn?

A. There is no need to fast prior to providing a sample for VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic; however, we do recommend drinking plenty of water before the test.

Q. What will I need for my mobile phlebotomy visit?

A. Please have your Laboratory Requisition form and VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic Draw/Ship Kit with you for your mobile phlebotomy visit.

Q. How soon after I have my blood drawn will I receive my lab test result?

A. Your allergist will arrange with you the best way to communicate your lab test result. Typically, VeriMAP[™] Peanut Diagnostic result is available to your allergist within 7 days of having your blood drawn.

Q. How do I access my lab test result?

A. We suggest you contact your allergist's office to set up an appointment to obtain and discuss your results. You may access your lab test result directly by contacting AllerGenis at 888-436-6339. Once requested, your result will be mailed to you within thirty days.
