## How are point scales determined?

- All the items listed on the next slide are divided into <u>Major</u>, <u>Intermediate</u>, <u>Minor</u> events and <u>Non-Ranked</u> categories.
- All Major events are worth 600 points. First place gets 600 points, second place gets 500, and like that, each place gets 100 points less.
- All Intermediate events are worth 300 points. First place gets 300 points, second place gets 250 points, and like that, each place gets 50 points less.
- All Minor events are worth 120 points. First place gets 120 points, second place gets 100, and like that, each place gets 20 points less.
- All Non-Ranked categories will get a custom amount of points based on the significance of the category.

## Non-Ranked Points Categories

- Order Service Project (one assigned per semester)

- Violations
  - 5 points deducted per violation
  - 10 points added for no violations
- Leader Attendance to Leadership Meetings
  - 5 points per meeting for elected leaders
