

The purpose of Sikh Heritage BC (SHBC) is to celebrate the contributions and aspirations of all Sikh-Canadians and to develop a greater understanding and appreciation of a rich, unique, and diverse heritage. Sikhs have been in BC for over 100 years, and this is an opportunity to showcase their contribution to the economic, social, and cultural fabric of the province. This initiative is meant to help create awareness and appreciation for Sikhi in Canada. On April 30, 2019, the Sikh Heritage Month Act was formally recognized by the Government of Canada. This means that throughout Canada, in each and every year, April is to be known as "Sikh Heritage Month."

In accordance with our mandate, Sikh Heritage BC has established five \$1,500 scholarships to provide funding for post-secondary education. This scholarship is available to BC grade 12 students who will be attending a Post-Secondary Institute in September 2024 regardless of their ethnicity, religion, or status in Canada.

Application is due on January 15, 2024, at 11:59pm and decisions will be made at the beginning of March. Please submit application using the appropriate form linked on sikhheritagebc.ca/scholarships.
