Region's residents are the State's poor cousins

Families struggle with low wages and high cost of living

WHILE residents of ritzy Mosman in Sydney's North Shore have an average income of \$130,000 a year, workers on the Northern Rivers are among the lowest paid in NSW.

Tenterfield has the lowest total average income in the whole of the state at \$27.247.

This is closely followed by Kyogle at \$29,182, Richmond Valley at \$31,224; Byron Bay at \$33,438 and Lismore at \$34,461.

Of all of the local government areas on the Northern Rivers, people in Ballina earned the most, with an average income of \$36,844.

But that is still about \$12,000 less than the state average of \$48,755.



But Mr Davies believes there are solutions to our income woes.

"There are roles for all three levels of government to support affordable housing developments and public housing," he said.

"With transport, what we are going to see is that people will really suffer because we don't yet have effective options.

"NRSDC has been advocating very strongly that the State Government urgently develops an integrated transport strategy to come up with a modern, best practice solution.

'There's a young woman I know who was training to become a childcare worker.

"But she had to travel from Kyogle to Lismore every day, and it cost her \$10 a day.

"When you don't earn much, that is a lot of money."

The development of the National Broadband Network is also important in bridging the gap between regional and metropolitan incomes, Mr Davies says.

'We have very skilled people in our region," he said.

"Fast broadband will help us to look at how these people can access what used to be city-based jobs."

Women turning to domestic violence

AN APPARENT increase in women being charged with domestic violence-related assaults will be one of the issues explored by a new State Government inquiry.

The NSW Legislative Council's Standing Committee on Social Issues is calling on all interested people and stakeholders to contribute to the inquiry which will investigate strategies to reduce breaches and improve compliance with Apprehended Domestic Violence Orders. Lennox Head-based Liberal MLC, Catherine Cusack, who sits on the committee, said the committee will also look into new technologies such as GPS bracelets. "We have picked up some disturbing trends that we don't understand and the minister wants that looked into," she said "I've been involved in (domestic violence) inquiries before but unfortunately it just keeps going on.

"It's not an issue we seem to be able to find the answer to but we have to keep updating our legislation and our technology and I'm hoping this inquiry will focus on things that work and will help ensure that the government is better focusing its resources.

"Domestic violence, family violence - it appears that there are more women perpetrators, that police are having to act against more women and we don't understand that. Is that because more offences are being committed, or because the laws are not being used properly or is it that more resources are directed to men

The committee will also look at early intervention strategies to prevent domestic violence and whether existing penalties for domestic violence are adequate.

Initial hearings will be held on October 21 and December 5 and a report is expected mid next year.
