

# WEDDING TIMELINE:



When it comes to Weddings, being organised is SO important, not just for yourself but for your Bridal clients too!

For me, having a time schedule that I send out prior to the Wedding Day is what keeps me focused and it allows my Bridal clients to organise themselves before I've even arrived.

Below is an example of how I work:  
(I usually allow 45mins per service and an hour or so for each of the Bride's services but you can tailor this to whatever suits you and your clients)

Remember, it's always good to allow 'buffer time' for any changes or hiccups that may occur throughout the morning so that you and your clients never feel 'rushed' or 'stressed'.

## **Wedding Schedule EXAMPLE:**

**Wedding date:** Sat 16th November 2019

**Location of where you'll be getting ready:** Fennes, CM1

**Services:** Bride MU Bride HAIR Bridesmaid Hair x3 (5 services)

**Time you want to be ready by:** 1.30pm

8am Zoe arrives to set up

8.30am **START Bride Hair/Skin prep**

9.15am Bridesmaid 1 Hair

10am Bridesmaid 2 Hair

10.45am Bride Hair

11.30 am Bride MU

12.15pm Bridesmaid 3 Hair

(Bride should consider getting herself prepped to be Dressed)

1pm Finishing touches/Pack Away

**1.30pm Finish**

Total for 5 services:

I then ask my Bride to double check that she's happy and allow her to edit and adjust including the names of the Bridal party.

Giving a more professional AND personal service is so important in this line of work!

Keep to a schedule, it's professional and it allows you to keep your COOL.
