Key Takeaways

- 1. The law is holy, but rules alone don't give us power to keep them.
- 2. In Christ, you can have victory over sin.
- 3. Reject the lies that keep you in bondage to sin.
- 4. Never underestimate the power of Jesus in your life.

Discussion

- 1. How do you personally relate to Paul's struggle described in Romans 7, and in what ways have you experienced the tension between knowing what is right and actually doing it?
- 2. How does understanding the context of Romans 7 as potentially describing a pre-Christ condition change your perspective on the Christian's struggle with sin?
- 3. What are some of the 'lies and excuses' you've encountered in your own life when dealing with temptation, and how can awareness of these help in overcoming sin?
- 4. How can you balance the reality of ongoing temptation with the promise of victory in Christ, avoiding both complacency and despair?
- 5. How can understanding the limitations of the law (as described by Paul) deepen your appreciation for the grace and power available through Christ?

Practical Applications

- 1. Commit to memorizing Romans 6 (or portions of it) over the next few weeks to combat temptation.
- 2. Write a short description of what "victory in Christ" looks like in your life.
- 3. Spend time each day this week specifically praying for God's power to overcome a particular struggle or challenge in your life.
